### **Background on our learning facilitator Dave Robb:**

**Dave Robb** is originally from Mesa, Arizona. He brings 36 years of coaching experience and in particular has worked with hitters at the college, professional and international levels. He was an assistant coach with Team Canada, in the Oakland A's system, and played as a player at Cal-State Fullerton. Dave also coached the Calgary Dawgs of the WMBL to a championship in 2004. With 7 consecutive playoff wins during the 2004 season his team won the WMBL Championship. In recognition of his outstanding effort, Coach Robb was named the WMBL "Coach of the Year". Currently Dave works closely with the Okotoks Dawgs and Okotoks Baseball Academy.
